2. WHAT DOES THIS JOB DO?

To provide network operation and field support to current and future Non-Revenue Water (NRW) projects to facilitate achievement of the NRW strategy.

As a member of the Network Intelligence Team, you will be actively involved in both the District Metered Area (DMA) Program project delivery and NRW Performance tasks by undertaking field investigations and providing operational support for both areas. In addition, you will also lead field activities for the planning, construction and integration of new infrastructure related to the DMA Program.

Responsibilities:

DMA Program Duties

Provision of operational input, knowledge and field support across the following areas:

- Be a point of operational technical advice for queries during project development, delivery and implementation.
- Communicate with key stakeholders on the status of works or to seek input to projects.
- Support site suitability assessments for the positioning of new field devices.
- Inspection and operation of network fittings to ensure efficient system operation.
- Issuing work orders for the maintenance of defective and missing fittings.
- Undertaking water main shutdown risk assessments and impacts to extended areas.
- Contribute to the planning and operation of critical and complex network changes to reduce the risk of impacting customers or cancelling works.
- Coordinate and/or perform water main shutdowns, including isolation, de-watering and recharging as required for high criticality shutdowns.

NRW Performance Duties

- Undertake reactive field based investigations resulting from alerts generated from either network data analytics, manual network monitoring or other operational activities.
- Issue Work Orders to Maintenance Contractors to accurately locate and/or repair faults identified.
- Employ acoustic leak detection techniques to identify leaking or faulty assets.
- Perform operational activities to verify network operation for NRW initiatives, such as;
 - o validation of flowmeter performance (flow rates and directions).
 - o integrity of zone boundaries.

- valve operation and scenarios to eliminate leakage through valves (such as boundary, shut, scour and reflux valves).
- o sub-metering of areas to determine background leakage.
- Confidently estimate flow rates of leakage found for capture in reporting systems.
- Assist and provide specialised leakage locating advice to others as required.
- Capture all investigations and outcomes in Maximo in a timely manner to ensure that reporting on NRW performance can be undertaken monthly.
- Assist with the preparation of event response plans and procedures for District Metered Areas.
